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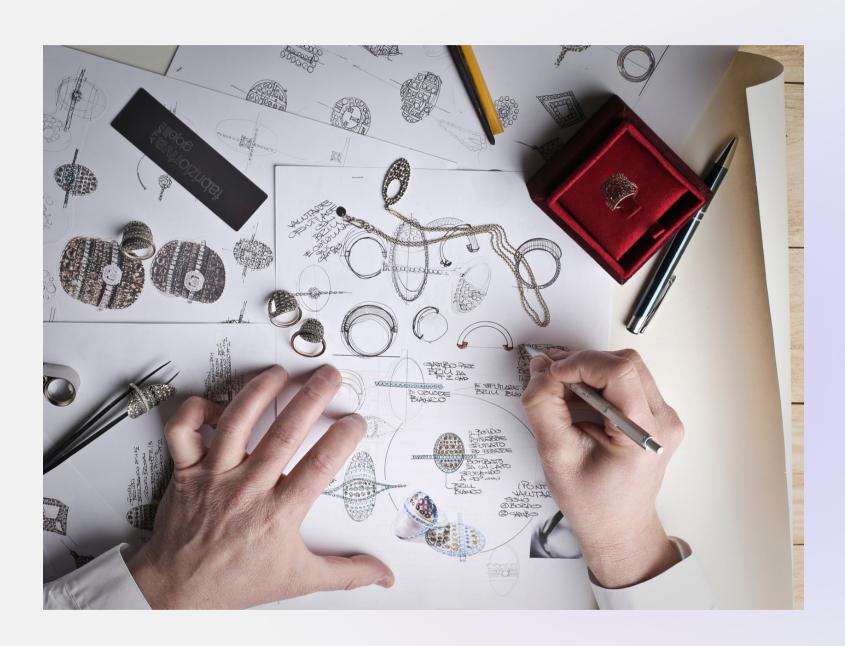
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The Project

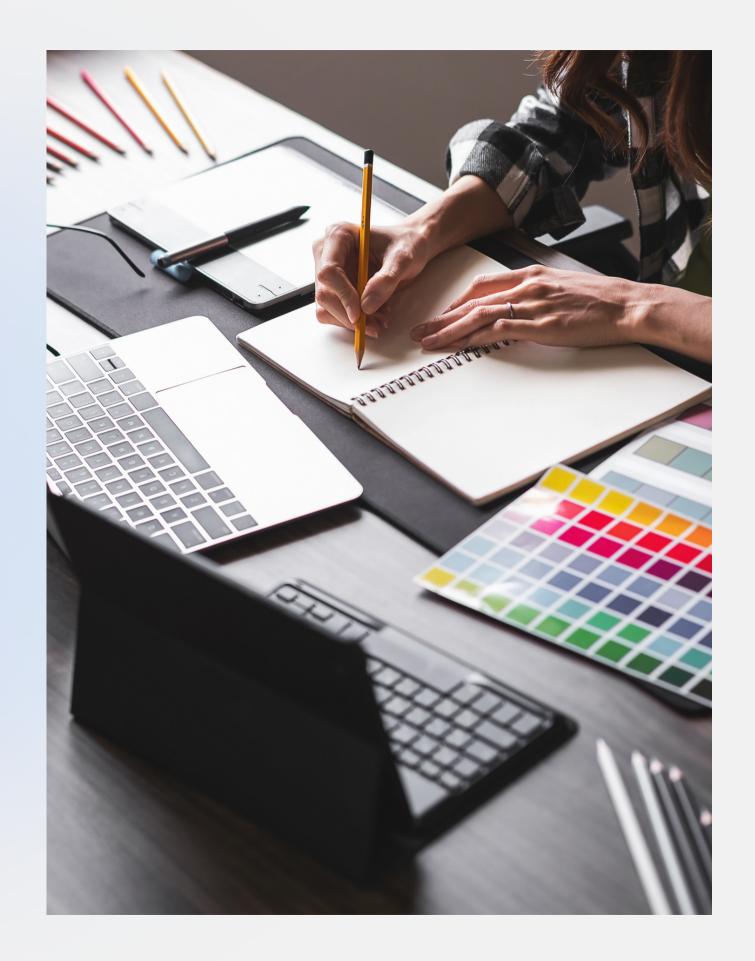
Mali Construction

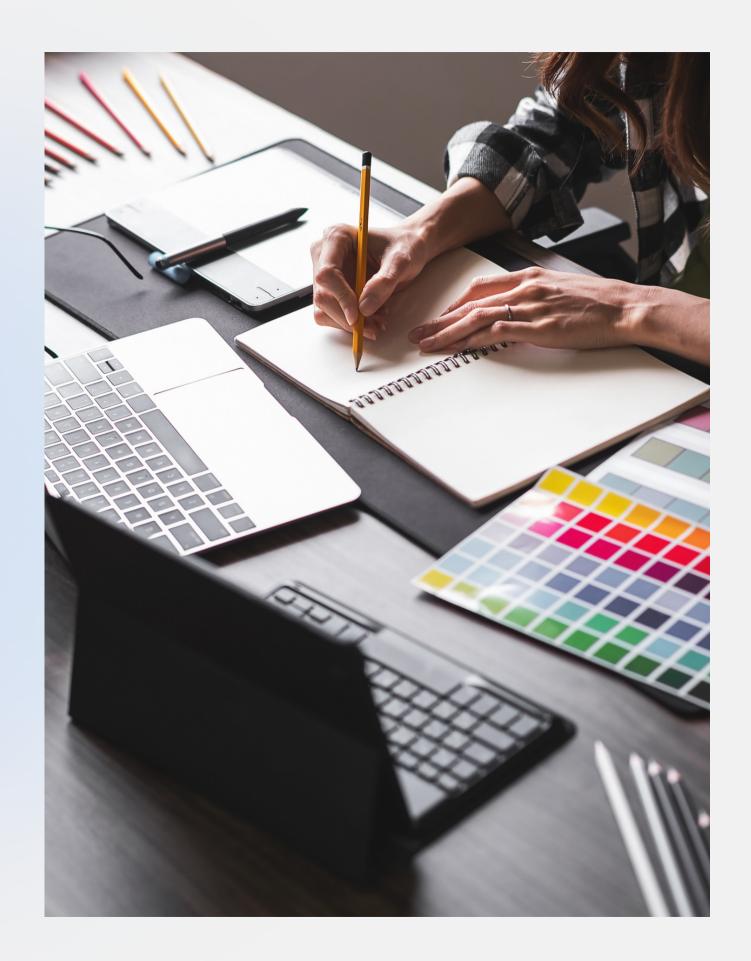
Requirements

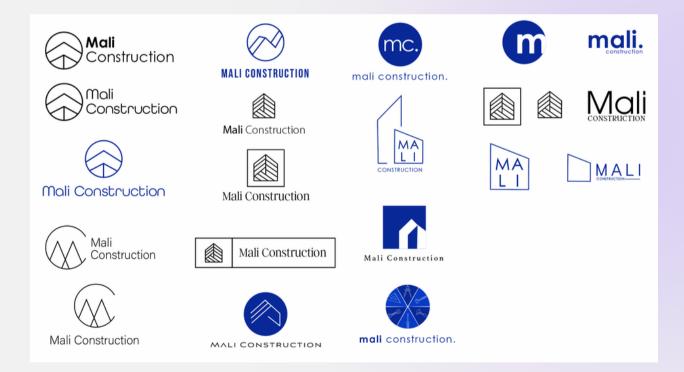
Creation

Creation



During the creation stage I took on board what the client had asked for and the research I had done to create multiple options. I used adobe illustrator to create the logos. I knew that I had to create some form of icon mark for the client that could be paired with text. With the client wanting something modern and unique I explored with using line drawings for the icon to stray away from industry norms.

It was important for me to explore with different shapes that i could use for line drawings as it had to represent the company in some form.

I also looked at colour palettes. The client only wanted blue so I experimented with a couple different shades of blue but a concrete colour palette wasn't needed for this client.

From the logo options I created I presented the client with three of them. To aid the client's decision-making process, I complemented these logos with professional mockups and stationary designs to showcase their real-world applications.
